SUNROOM

Enter/Exit: Fellowship Hall back door (Door #3) on Common Street

Drop-Off: 8:25 AM

Pick-Up: 11:50 AM or 1:00 PM (if staying for lunch)

DISCOVERY ROOM

Enter/Exit: Purpose School front door (Door #2) on Church Street

Drop-Off: 8:25 AM

Pick-Up: 11:50 AM or 1:00 PM (if staying for lunch)

BEGINNINGS ROOM

Enter/Exit: Ramp door (Door #7) on Common Street

Drop-Off: 8:25 AM

Pick-Up: 11:50 AM or 1:00 PM (if staying for lunch)

RAINBOW ROOM

Enter/Exit: Church Office door (Door #1) on Church Street

Drop-Off: 8:35 AM

Pick-Up: 12:00 PM or 1:00 PM (if staying for lunch)

STAR ROOM

Enter/Exit: Front door of the church sanctuary (Door #10) on Main Street

Drop-Off: 8:35 AM

Pick-Up: 12:00 PM or 1:00 PM (if staying for lunch)

If you arrive after your designated drop-off time, please use the Purpose School front door (Door #2). Ring the bell, and a staff member will greet your child and escort them to their classroom.

Important Reminders:

- Please send your child with a labeled snack and water bottle each day. Snack and lunch should be packed in two separate, clearly labeled bags or containers.
- Lunch service will begin on Wednesday, September 9, 2026.

- When contacted, please join Class Dojo to become part of your classroom's private group.
- On Tuesday, September 8, each classroom will host brief tours. Once you receive the email, please sign up for a morning time slot using SignUpGenius to visit your child's classroom.
